

THE BEAST OUT OF THE SEA (PART 2)

Rev. 13:1-10

September 1, 2019

We must prepare ourselves and those we know for the arrival of "THE" Fake Jesus who will be known by 6 characteristics:

1. HIS ARRIVAL

"And I saw a beast rising out of the sea, with ten horns and seven heads, with ten diadems on its horns and blasphemous names on its heads." Rev. 13:1

...He gradually emerges out of the sea of HUMANITY.

2. HIS APPEARANCE

"And the beast that I saw was like a leopard; its feet were like a bear's, and its mouth was like a lion's mouth. Rev. 13:1b-2a

...He will RULE the world.

3. HIS ASSOCIATION

"And to it the dragon gave his power and his throne and great authority." Rev. 13:2b

...He derives his POWER and POSITION from Satan.

4. HIS APPEAL

"One of its heads seemed to have a mortal wound, but its mortal wound was healed, and the whole earth marveled as they followed the beast." Rev. 13:3

...The world will MARVEL at and FOLLOW Fake Jesus because of his fake RESURRECTION.

5. HIS AIM

"And they worshiped the dragon, for he had given his authority to the beast, and they worshiped the beast, saying, 'Who is like the beast, and who can fight against it?' And the beast was given a mouth uttering haughty and blasphemous words, and it was allowed to exercise authority for forty-two months. It opened its mouth to utter blasphemies against God, blaspheming his name and his dwelling, that is, those who dwell in heaven. And it was also allowed to make war on the saints and to conquer them. And authority was given it

over every tribe and people and language and nation, and all who dwell on earth will worship it, everyone whose name has not been written before the foundation of the world in the book of life of the Lamb who was slain.” Rev. 13:4-8

...Fake Jesus will extend the 5 fold AIM of Satan in the world:

- a. To Overshadow EVERYONE ! (vs. 4)
- b. To Overthrow GOD ! (vs. 5-6)
- c. To Overcome the SAINTS ! (vs. 6-7)
- d. To Overpower the WORLD ! (vs. 7)
- e. To Overtake the LAMB ! (vs. 8)

6. HIS ADVERSARIES

"If anyone has an ear, let him hear: If anyone is to be taken captive, to captivity he goes; if anyone is to be slain with the sword, with the sword must he be slain. Here is a call for the endurance and faith of the saints." Rev. 13:9-10
